

## AFPMBAI releases P42M in dividends

**The Board of Trustees of the Armed Forces and Police Mutual Benefit Association, Inc (AFPMBAI) headed by the Chief of Staff Gen Alexander B Yano AFP has approved the release of P42 million in dividends to qualified members starting April 20.**

Around 129, 175 policyholders from the AFP, PNP, Bureau of Fire Protection, Bureau of Jail Management and Penology, Philippine Coast Guard, as well as civilians, who have participating insurance in force before January 1, 2006 will benefit from the said dividends.

Members may claim their dividends from the Association's Camp Aguinaldo Head Office, regional offices and the Palawan Extension Office at 416 Escamilla Bldg., Tizal Ext., Puerto Princesa City.

For those whose payrolls are through ATM, their dividends shall be released through their respective ATMs starting April 20.

Representatives of members who will claim dividends must present an authorization letter and an original as well as a photocopy of a valid ID of both the members and the representative. Only the following valid IDs shall be accepted: AFP, PNP, BJMP, PCG and BFD ID; retired personnel/senior citizen ID; civilian employee ID; student/dependent's ID, driver's license; passport; PRC/GSIS/SSS and BIR ID with picture.

Starting next year, dividends will be released on the effectivity month of the member's insurance policy.
