

TULONG MEDICAL-DENTAL MISSION 2009 AT TAYABAS QUEZON

The 3rd Communications, Electronics and Information Systems Group (3CEISG) under the supervision of MAJ DELFIN A OCO PAF, sponsored a Medical, Dental, Circumcision, Feeding Program, Tree Planting, Donation of Trash Cans/Used Clothing, Lecture on Composting Fertilizer, Charcoal Briquette and Film Showing at Dapdap Elementary School, Brgy Dapdap, Tayabas Quezon near the vicinity of **Lukban Radio Relay Station** on 18 April 2009, in collaboration with 304th, 313th CECO, SOLCOM Medical/Dental team, TOG-4 personnel, Tayabas Municipal Health office, DOH, DENR, GLOBE telecom personnel, SMART, DIGITEL, PCSO, SOLCOM personnel, from OU6 and OU7, local media, members of ALPHA PHI OMEGA fraternity, Phil Guardian Brotherhood Tayabas Chapter, 2nd SF company, PNP Tayabas and Brgy Council of Dapdap and Brgy Volunteers (Brgy Tanods).

As per direction from CEISSAFP Commander, BGEN RICARDO B BUTALID JR (MNSA) AFP, the planning and coordination started as early as February 2009. The estimated number of beneficiaries was around 827 people based on the initial survey and coordination with the local officials. Thus availability of medicine sponsors, medical doctors to include surgeon for the circumcision/minor and adults, surgery cases and dentists was a crucial factor. MAJ OCO and his deputy CPT ABUEG PAF lost no time and touched base with the various stakeholders just to ensure success of the CIVAC efforts.

The active contribution and participation of other AFP units, Local Government officials, other agencies of the government, NGO's and telecommunication companies led to a big factor in the successful implementation of the mission as they provided medicines, doctors, nurses to include a surgeon. They enthusiastically worked hand-in-hand with the Medical Team and Dental team. As a result, a total of 827 individuals benefited from the mission broken down into 193 medical cases, 145 dental cases, 350 feeding program, 20 participants on DENR representative lecture on composting and charcoal briquette, 16 attendees on film showing and 103 males availed the circumcision. Patients were also given free medicines.
