Today, LCDR CORNELIO RODEL D MAGO PN, CPT BLADIMER B CALUYA PN (M) and seventeen (17) other enlisted personnel and civilian employees now belong to an elite class of IT specialists who possess the fundamental knowledge and validated skills to install, configure, manage and troubleshoot medium-sized local and wide area networks.

More importantly, they are living hallmarks of this unprecedented achievement in the history of the Armed Forces of the Philippines.

MAJOR ROLEEN M DEL PRADO PA, the "Visionary" Group Commander of CEISSAFP's Information Systems Group (ISG) and MAJOR WALLY ICARO PA, from the Army Management Information Center (AMIC) played critical roles all throughout the training period. Together, they facilitated the ten (10) month long training in network fundamentals, routing protocols, switching and wireless systems and wide area networks. Their efforts, coupled with the commitment and "full support" of BGEN RICARDO B BUTALID JR AFP, paid off during the CCNA commencement exercises held at headquarters CEISSAFP last July 17, 2009.

For the unfamiliar, a CISCO certification is a class in its own. CISCO is a multinational corporation known for providing commercially successful IP-based designs, networking hardware and services. Its 7500 series router ranked as the third most important product of the decade (1990-2000). In 2003, CISCO was the recipient of the ron a brown award, a presidential award given to companies that demonstrate a distinguished commitment to innovation and initiatives empowering and propelling strategic business interests. This dominance and reputation in the industry allows CISCO to influence and dictate computer networking standards on a global scale.

In this age of convergence, CEISSAFP's CISCO accreditation and its "home-grown" network professionals are a giant leap forward in revolutionizing the AFP wide area network as an enterprise class computer network at par with other modern military IT structures and professionals.
