

# CEISSAFP PERSONNEL RECEIVE HAZARDOUS PAY

Something big happened to CEISSAFP personnel lately. After a long time, Army personnel from 1CEISG received hazardous pay equivalent to 50% of their respective base pays in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2009. While PAF personnel from the 5CEISG were paid of the same entitlement for the months of



January and February this year. Other members of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>CEISG and IMG shall be enjoying the same privilege soon.

Hazardous pay is a privilege given to those who perform dangerous duties such as those defined in *Circular 6 dated 8 Oct 2004*. Not all personnel are



granted with the authority to perform hazardous duty. Only linemen, electricians, ACU, microwave and switch technicians are entitled to this collateral entitlement. So these personnel are now in the same league as the PAF pilots and members of the EOD units as well as medical personnel who enjoy receiving

the amount equivalent to half of their base pays.

Certainly, this is a tremendous boost to the morale and welfare of CEISSAFP personnel who are burdened of thinking how to go about their family's subsistence each passing day. To those who wanted to avail of the collateral entitlement, now is the time to upgrade your skills. Go on schooling and start performing the duties you are shying away from.

Calling on ISG and HHSB leaderships, file your claims for your eligible personnel.

Kudos to the administration personnel of concerned groups, AC of CEISS Staff for Pers, C1 and the Command Finance Office, your efforts in pushing for the payment of the claim deserve the accolade of **TEAM CEISSAFP**. These entitlements only show how **TEAM AFP** takes care of its men and women!
