WHEREAS, pursuant to the AFP SOP Nr 9,s-2017 (Guidelines Statement of Assets, Liabilities and Net Worth), s-2017 in conjunction with CSC Memorandum Circular 15, s- 2015, the prescribed penalty for failure to file SALN are as follows:

a. Non-filing

1st Offense

- Suspension of One Month & 1 day to 6 months

- Dismissal from the Service

b. Unlawfully taking/use of any statement filed for purposes contrary to morals or public policy or any commercial purpose other than by news and communications media for dissemination to the general public (Section 8, RA 6713). Imprisonment not exceeding five (5) years, or a fine not exceeding FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PhP 5,000.00) or both at the discretion of court.

WHEREAS, in addition, pursuant to the same authority, non SALN filers are not entitled to the Performance Based Bonus.

RESOLVE AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that personnel who failed to file SALN be investigated by the concerned OESPA and impose the appropriate administrative sanction/s pursuant to applicable laws, rules and regulations, as may be warranted by evidence.
